

## **OAAS BUSINESS PLAN COMMITTEE REQUEST FOR MEMBERS**

In response to the motion made at the Annual General Meeting of the OAAS “to strike an ad hoc committee of OAAS members and stakeholders to draw up a business plan to determine the economic feasibility of hiring a full-time staff member to represent OAAS interests; the findings are to be presented at the Fall 2010 OAAS Board of Directors’ Meeting”; the Directors of the OAAS voted to structure the ad hoc committee with 4 OAAS Directors, 4 representatives from Fairs and 2 additional stakeholder members.

The motion at the post-Convention OAAS Directors’ meeting was “that the four Fair representatives be selected from the following gate receipts levels: \$0-7,000; \$7,001-\$30,000; \$30,001 - \$70,000; \$70,001 and over.” The additional 2 stakeholder representatives are to be selected by these 8 members.

In order to have this committee in place as soon as possible, the OAAS requests interested Fairs to nominate members for this committee. It is recommended that nominated members have some knowledge or experience with creating a business plan and working with full time staff.
